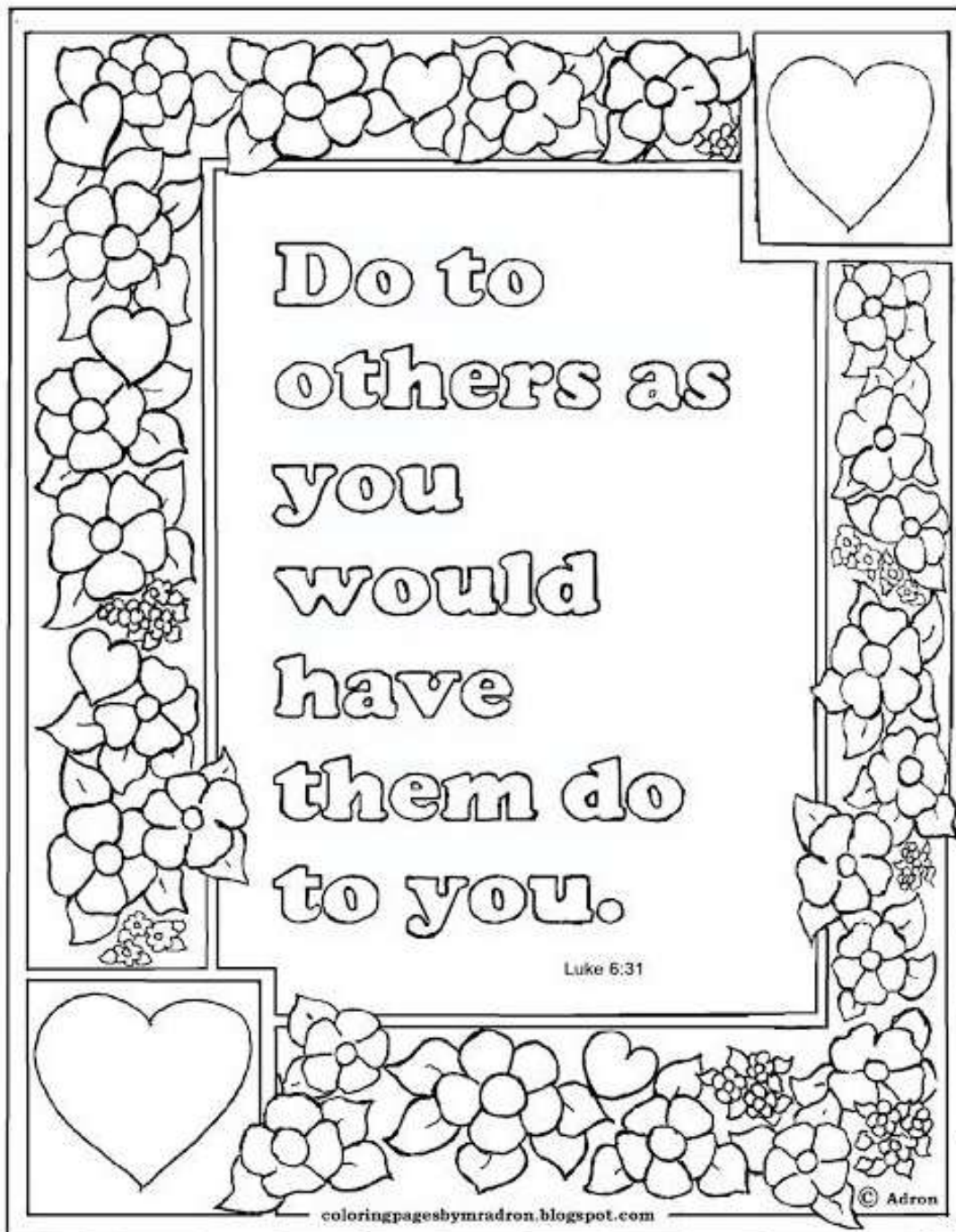

# The Golden Rule Craft

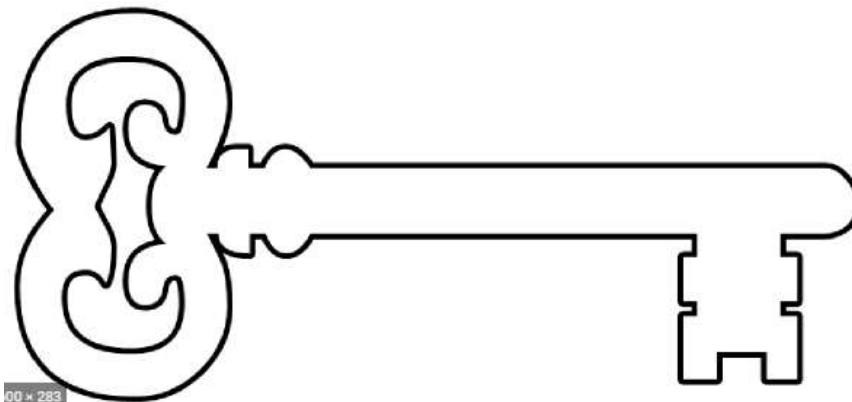


## The Golden Rule Craft
