

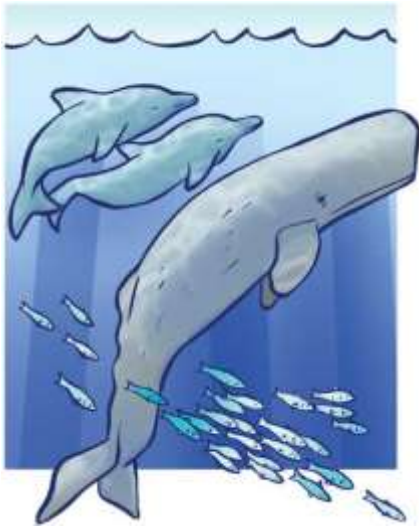

# A New World

I give you all the seed-bearing plants and fruits of the trees for food. I give every creature every green plant for food." God looked at everything that He had made, and it was very good. This was the sixth day of Creation.

## Making Basic Slime



### You will Need:

- 1 large plastic container
- A glass
- A bottle of water
- Liquid glue
- Borax
- A mixing utensil
- Food coloring

## Instructions:

- **Step One** Pour 4 oz. of white glue into a mixing bowl, then add food coloring of your choice and mix in with a spoon.
- **Step Two** Add 2 oz. of borax solution a little bit at a time.
- **Step Three** Once all the borax is mixed in, begin kneading the mixture with your hands.
- **Step Four** When the slime begins to pull away from the sides of the bowl take it out of the bowl and begin kneading and stretching it.
- **Step Five** Store in an airtight container and enjoy playing with your slime.

**Remember, this craft reminds us of how Jesus transforms us to make us his new creation, when we accept him into our hearts.**
